- have a President.

<p>Membership:</p>	<p>Membership of the PTA is open to all parents or carers of a child attending KPS and to all KPS staff members.</p> <p>Roles include being on the core committee and being a class representative.</p>
<p>Purpose:</p>	<p>The purpose of the PTA is to support the school, its students, staff and community.</p>
<p>Objectives:</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To contribute to the wellbeing of the school community.</li> <li>2. To encourage the participation of all parents/carers in the life of the school.</li> <li>3. To provide social activities for students, parents/carers and staff and to provide opportunities for parents/carers and staff to get to know each other.</li> <li>4. To raise funds for the benefit of the students and the school.</li> <li>5. To engage parents/carers, staff and the wider community in fundraising activities for the benefit of the school.</li> <li>6. To keep the school updated about the activities of the PTA.</li> </ol>
<p>Operation:</p>	<p>The views and involvement of all parents/carers and staff are welcomed.</p> <p>The PTA has a nominated President, Vice-President and Treasurer.</p> <p>The PTA will work in cooperation with the School Council, the Principal and staff.</p> <p>The PTA will report to School Council regularly.</p>
<p>Meeting calendar:</p>	<p>The PTA will meet approximately once per month during term time.</p>
